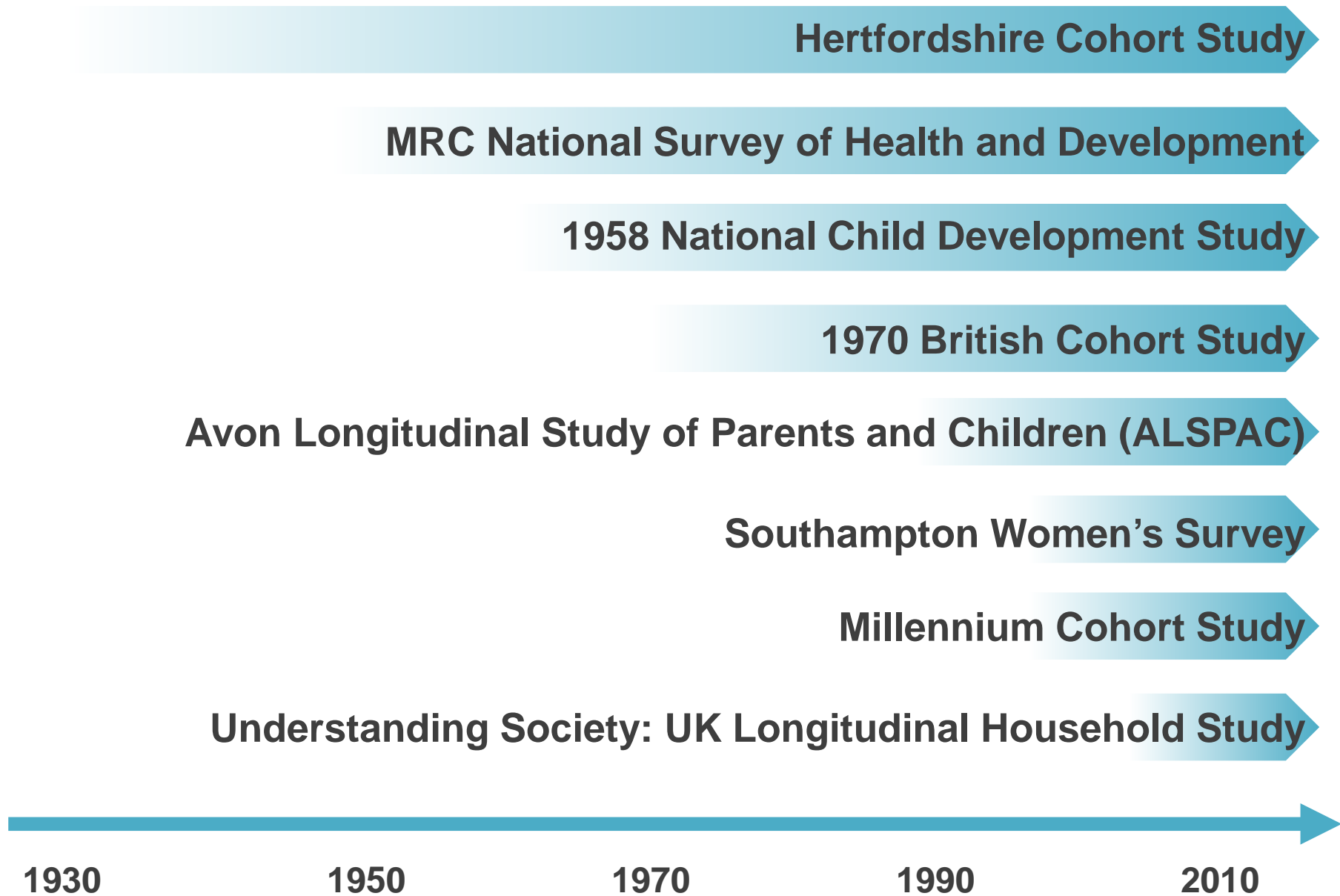

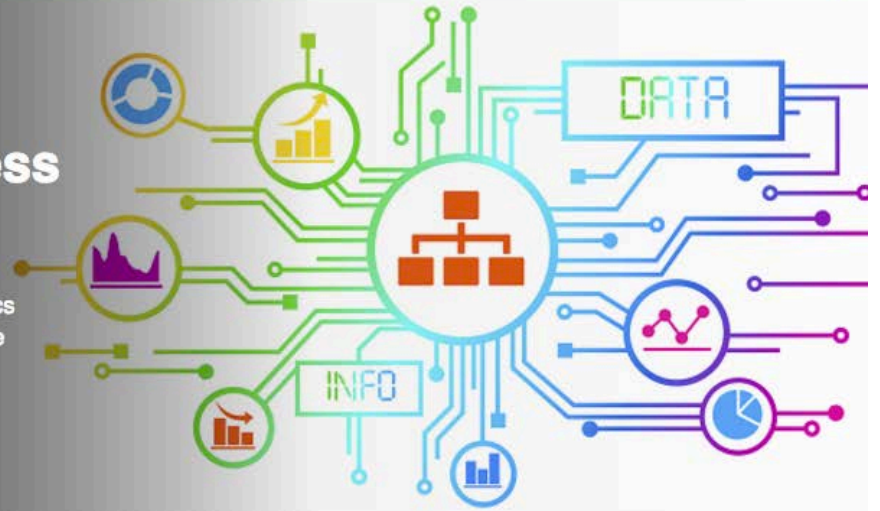

- What is the difference between data and information?
 - Context
- What gives data context?
 - Metadata
- Metadata + Data = Information

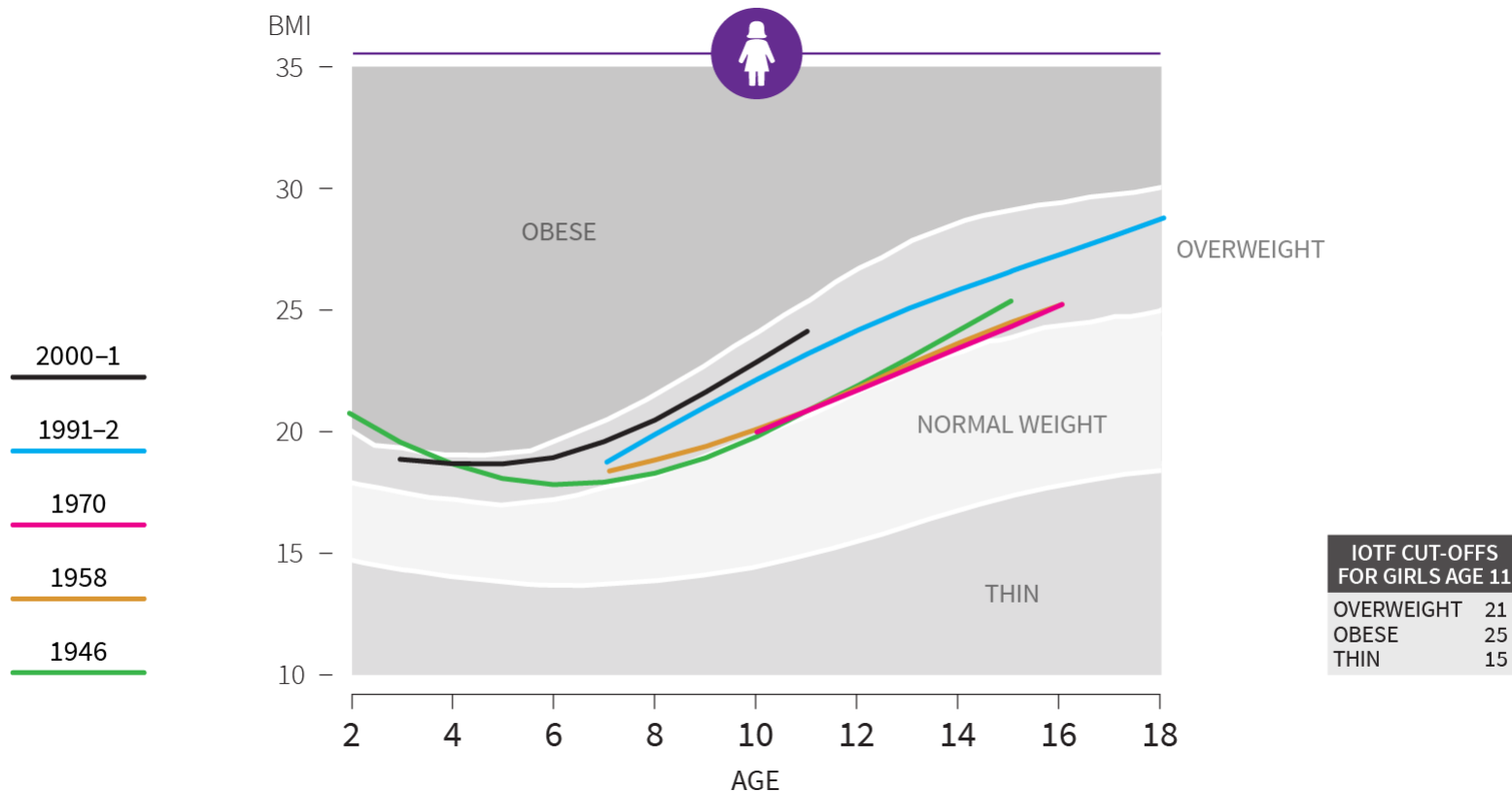

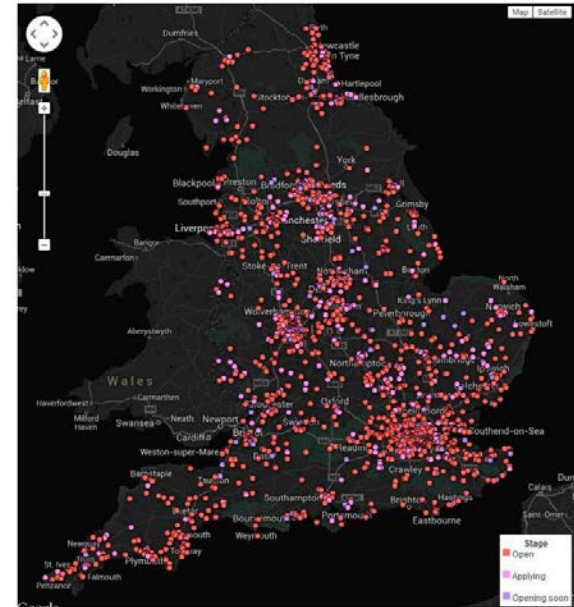
