- Large sample \rightarrow subgroup analyses

Research Example

How does **Education** levels affect the Chances of being in employment over The life course?



DATA AND ANALYSES

Sample: 16-24 (n=65234) tracked forward 40 years

Outcome = economic activity (obtained at census every 10 years, 3 nominal categories)



Model specification

Multinomial logistic regression ORs adjusted for:

Economic activity at last FU, age group, education level, married (Y/N), self-reported sickness from last FU_{'01+'11}, child in HH, illness in HH members, spouse working, Carstairs deprivation quintiles

ORs significantly lower than 1 shows "protection" from being in workless economic state of those with increasing levels of education

This protection weakens in mid-life for those with GCSE/O-level equivalent education

This protection against being unemployed/other inactive strengthens in mid- to later-life
